Consultant or Project Manager of the Year

Consultants and project managers can be nominated as part of a project entry if their contribution is highlighted clearly within that entry.

If you wish to nominate someone or enter yourself only for the Consultant or Project Manager of the Year award you must provide a statement explaining why the individual or company in question is a worthy winner.

Where possible, worthy winners should demonstrate the ability to:

- Present original proposals to meet a client's requirements;
- Develop innovative solutions to tackle challenges within a project;
- Successfully co-ordinate different stakeholders and contractors within a project;
- Deliver projects on-time, within budget and to the satisfaction of the client.

Outstanding Contribution to AV

This award recognises individuals who have positively changed the AV industry.

If you wish to nominate someone or enter yourself for the Outstanding Contribution award you must provide a statement explaining how the individual in question has positively impacted the AV industry.

We're specifically looking for those that have had an impact felt beyond their own organisation.

Areas where worthy winners may have excelled:

- Pioneered a change in AV industry operations (eg related to safety, standards or procedures);
- Invented or commercialised a remarkable progression of an existing or new technology;
- Champion of AV to other industries;
- Encouraged and promoted achievements of others.

Entry Guidelines & The Small Print

Our awards are simple to enter and are open to any company working within the professional AV industry. The information below will help you to prepare your entry.

When the entry system opens on September 1, 2021, please click ENTER NOW at the top of the inavationawards.com site and select the category you wish to enter.

Entry is free

Inavation Business Awards concentrate primarily on activity within the last 12 months before submission deadline, so for 2022 our judges will be looking for outstanding examples of best practice between October 1, 2020 and October 1, 2021.

We will accept submissions based on projects, initiatives or endeavours that commenced prior to this period, provided that core achievements have taken place during the 12 months stipulated.

All entries must be submitted online.

The judges will be looking for a good story, well told, and backed up with solid metrics where applicable.

Submissions should consist of up to 2,000 words of text specifically addressing how the entrant has excelled in the relevant category. You may also include supporting materials, which should be no more than six sides of A4 in total.

If you wish to submit tables, they should be included within your supporting materials rather than the text field.

You may enter as many categories as you wish, but you must complete a separate submission for each one.

You may not submit more than one entry per category. If projects or initiatives are distinctive and unrelated we advise you to combine the best elements of each in a stronger single entry.

No submission should be entered in more than one category. Please choose the most appropriate single category for your entry. If you are unsure which category to choose, please contact inavationawards@imlgroup.co.uk

We are planning for the winners to be announced at a gala ceremony in Barcelona on February 1, 2022.

Documents should be in PDF or Word doc format. PowerPoint files will not be accepted.

Supporting materials may include photographs, tables, graphs, documents containing statistics, testimonials, and media coverage. We encourage video however please provide a link to video hosted elsewhere rather than a video file. Any information submitted outside these guidelines will not be considered.

Ensure that your submission contains sufficient robust information. Please include relevant facts and figures where possible.
